Study Suggestions for the Graduate Music Theory Placement Exam:

For the Music Theory placement exam, study your undergraduate theory texts, especially the second-year material, such as chromatic chords, N6, augmented 6th chords, modulation, secondary dominants and secondary 7th chords. Also, you can check out the Benward theory books (Music in Theory and Practice).

Specifics:

- 1) Dictation (melodic and harmonic)
- 2) Sight-singing
- 3) Analysis of musical excerpts, including advanced chromatic chords and modulations
- 4) Part-writing, including chromatic harmony
- 5) Theory exercises (writing cadences, etc.).
