Her work often revolves around skill sharing to create multiethnic and intergenerational sewing circles, which become a place for empowerment, subversion and protest. Her work has been exhibited at the Pulitzer Arts Foundation, Jane Addams Hull-House Museum, Chicago Cultural Center Asian Arts Initiative, Chung Young Yang Embroidery Museum, the Design Museum and others. The artist is currently based in Chicago.
