Non-UF Students

- This program is open to all creative artists interested in the intersection of arts in health.
- Must register for the program through the UF International Center website
- Must interview with one of the program professors, Colleen Rua, Jeffrey Pufahl, or Antonio Sajid Lopez

18 spots are available for this trip and participation is granted by the course instructors on a rolling basis. Spots are guaranteed upon receipt of a nonrefundable deposit.

All travelers to Puerto Rico must present proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a negative PCR test taken within 3 days of arrival.
