\* Presumes student begins theory sequence with <u>Music Theory 1</u> (MUT 1111). Students who place into <u>Introduction to Music Theory</u> <u>Rudiments</u> (MUT 1001) will take MUT 1111 & 1241L in the spring, followed by MUT 1112 & 1242L in the summer.

\*\* Students can either complete Introduction to World Musics (MUH 2501) or any MUH 3000/4000-level course.

\*\*\* <u>Counterpoint</u> and <u>Form & Analysis</u> are offered on an alternating basis. If semester 5 falls in an even year, the student will take the two <u>Counterpoint</u> courses (semesters 5 & 6) followed by the two <u>Form & Analysis</u> courses (semesters 7 & 8).

\*\*\*\* Offered spring semester, even years only – If semester 6 falls in an odd year, MUT 3322 must be taken semester 8 instead.

\*\*\*\*\* Students must complete at least 54 credits at the 3000/4000 level. Elective courses should be taken at this level until requirement is satisfied.

\*K Keyboard principals should take <u>Accompanying</u> (MVK 3702) instead of a 1000-level ensemble during semesters one and two.

\*V Voice principals should also complete the Diction sequence during their first year: MUS 2211 & 2241 (fall) / MUS 2221 & 2231 (spring).
