- * Presumes student begins theory sequence with Music Theory 1 (MUT 1111). Students who place into Introduction to Music Theory Rudiments (MUT 1001) will take MUT 1111 & 1241L in the spring, followed by MUT 1112 & 1242L in the summer.
- ** Counterpoint and Form & Analysis are offered on an alternating basis. If semester 5 falls in an even year, the student will take the two Counterpoint courses (semesters 5 & 6) followed by the two Form & Analysis courses (semesters 7 & 8).
- *** Offered spring semester, even years only – If semester 6 falls in an odd year, MUT 3322 must be taken semester 8 instead.
- **** Students can either complete Introduction to World Musics (MUH 2501) or any MUH 3000/4000-level course.
- ***** Students must complete at least 54 credits at the 3000/4000 level. Elective courses should be taken at this level until requirement is satisfied.
- *K Keyboard principals should take Accompanying (MVK 3702) instead of a 1000-level ensemble during semesters one and two.
- *V Voice principals should also complete the Diction sequence during their first year: MUS 2211 & 2241 (fall) / MUS 2221 & 2231 (spring).
