DAN 4905 COURSE CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

A reading, research, practical or creative project in an area of dance. Prerequisite: instructor permission.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This Individual Study serves as an alternative to the Production Workshop credit, offering students the opportunity to apply for an administrative position supporting the Young Dancers Workshop of North Central Florida—an annual event that brings together over 250 middle and high school dancers from across the region. Co-hosted by the UF School of Theatre + Dance and the Santa Fe College Dance Department, this conference-style event offers a weekend of classes, panel discussions, and performances. Students assist in preparing the Dance Area and its faculty to welcome participants and gain firsthand experience in coordinating a large-scale community event. The workshop showcases the breadth of the program through classes in diverse forms, including African/African Diasporic dance, Contemporary, Ballet, Dance-making, Partnering, Broadway, Yoga, Pilates, Jazz, and Improvisation.

The course is designed to cultivate awareness of dance and theatre production as it relates to creative work leading to performance, while also developing skills in arts administration, event planning, and production management. Students will gain insight into what it takes to produce repertory concerts, festivals, or conferences and will strengthen their ability to collaborate, lead, and problem-solve in a pre-professional creative environment.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of this course, students will:

- Expand their knowledge of technical theatre practices and/or event management within the field of dance.
- Develop an appreciation for both the creative and logistical aspects of production ("on both sides of the curtain").
- Strengthen organizational and management skills necessary for executing productions and events.
- Explore diverse approaches to the creative process and how these intersect with production.
- Enhance collaborative skills through team-based assignments and administrative tasks.
- Build professional responsibility and discipline through hands-on administrative and production-related experiences.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Attend weekly meetings with the Young Dancers Workshop (YDW) Faculty Co-Director.
- Fulfill administrative and production-related assignments as delegated.
- Contribute to the planning and orchestration of the Young Dancers Workshop.
- Assist in organizing, generating, and managing student volunteers for the event.
- Provide overall production support before and during the workshop.
- Attend and participate in all YDW events and classes.
- Complete written assignments, including readings and responses on dance production, a review of a professional dance work, and a reflection on the digital Fall BFA Dance Showcase.
