Attendance and Seating

This is a course completely dependent on attendance and participation. Class begins promptly. Your grade percentage will be lowered 3% for each absence. You will be counted tardy if you come in after class has started. Your grade percentage will be lowered 1% for each tardy; three tardies will equal one absence. Dress rehearsals count double.

Performances missed will result in an automatic fail.

Seating will be assigned on the first day of class and will be permanent for the semester. Attendance will be taken by a Graduate Assistant at the start of class. If you are not in your seat at the start of class, you will be recorded tardy. If you leave class after the break, you will be marked absent for the full rehearsal.

Please note: Make-up work is available for those wishing to remove absences; however, only PRE-APPROVED excuses may be made up. You must see a Graduate Assistant within one week of the absence to arrange make up work. The Graduate Assistant will not find you to make up the work and you may not come at the end of the semester to make up an absence from earlier

in the semester. Make up work will be equivalent to the amount of rehearsal time missed. If you miss a full 2-hour rehearsal, there will be 2 hours of make-up work to complete.

Phones and Texting

Phones are not allowed in class. Anyone found using their phone for any reason will be marked absent for that rehearsal.

Preparation & Professional Conduct

Preparation is expected or all rehearsals.

Bring your music and a pencil for marking your score. Each day in class without music will result in a 2% grade drop.

Your final grade will be determined by all of the above-mentioned criteria, in addition to attitude, attentiveness, cooperation, and professional conduct.
